**Frostburg ranks ninth in the nation in total defense after three games**

#### Setting the Scene

The fifth-ranked Bobcats face their biggest test of the season so far as they visit sixth-ranked Wesley on Saturday at Drass Field at Scott D. Miller Stadium in Dover. Both teams are undefeated and marks the second-straight season that the two schools are ranked inside the top 25 when they square off.

The Bobcats head to Delaware with a 3-0 mark after downing Stevenson (34-7), TCNJ (47-7) and Rowan (34-7) in their first three games. Last year, FSU and Wesley battled to a 27-24 overtime win for the Wolverines.

The Bobcats hold a 9-13 record in the series with Wesley and all 22 meetings have occurred since 1987.

Wesley enters the week at 4-0 following wins over Delaware Valley (34-10), TCNJ (62-0), William Paterson (43-7) and Southern Virginia (28-7). The Wolverines were picked to win the NJAC in the preseason coaches' poll after posting a 10-2 mark a year ago with the league championship trophy.

#### The Series

Frostburg and Wesley have met 22 times since the series started in 1987 and the Wolverines lead 13-9.

Frostburg won the first seven meetings and nine of the first 11 matchups, however, Wesley has won the last 11 contests.

The two schools have faced one another as conference foes at two different times during the series. From 1999-2010, Frostburg and Wesley were members of the Atlantic Central Football Conference (ACFC) and the two joined the NJAC as affiliate members prior to the 2015 campaign.

#### Scouting Wesley

Wesley (4-0, 3-0 NJAC) comes into the matchup against Frostburg ranked 5th in the country in the American Football Coaches Association poll and 6th in the country in the D3football.com Top 25 poll.

The Wolverines are led by head coach Chip Knapp, who is currently in his first season as a head coach in college football. Knapp enters his 29th season as a member of the Wesley coaching staff, after spending his first two seasons as a defensive assistant before being promoted to offensive coordinator in 1991.

Wesley's 4-0 start is the team's best start since the Wolverines started out 8-0 in

the 2015 season. Last week, Wesley scored a touchdown in every quarter in its 28-7 road victory over Southern Virginia after giving up an early touchdown. The Wolverines totaled 394 yards of total offense and 258 return yards, including a punt return touchdown from junior Corterris Simpson.

Through four games, the Wolverines are holding opponents to 232.5 yards per game, good for 15th in the nation. WC is also fourth in the nation and paces the NJAC by allowing just 103.0 yards per game through the air. Wesley is averaging 490.5 yards of total offense per game, the 19th-best mark in the country.

Senior quarterback Khaaliq Burroughs is leading the NJAC with 11 touchdown passes and is second in the conference with 1,028 passing yards so far this season, just 18 yards behind NJAC leader Jack Anderson of Christopher Newport. Burroughs threw for 280 yards and three touchdowns, while rushing for an additional 20 yards in Wesley's 34-10 victory over Delaware Valley in week one.

Alex Kemp leads the NJAC in receptions per game (5.8) and scoring (9.0) and has totaled 380 receiving yards with six touchdowns. Daquay Harris-Winbush leads the team in tackles with 27, while Coray Williams has 26.

#### Scouting Frostburg

Frostburg entered the 2018 campaign as one of the hottest teams in Division III with 21 wins over the last two seasons including two postseason appearances. Head coach DeLane Fitzgerald has increased Frostburg's win total in each of his four seasons at the helm after taking over a 1-9 program prior to his arrival.

Last fall, the Bobcats were part of the national playoff equation all season and finished with a school record 11 wins. Frostburg spent the entire season ranked inside the top 25, collected three wins against ranked opponents, beat two of Division III's winningest programs and was one of the final eight teams left standing in the NCAA Playoffs.

Through three games this fall, the Bobcats have carried that momentum from the last two seasons into '18 with a trio of dominating efforts.

In its season opener, Frostburg rushed past Stevenson, 34-7, behind 176 yards on the ground and four touchdowns. FSU finished with 430 yards in total offense against outmatched Stevenson.

In week two, the Bobcats visited Ewing, N.J. and came away with a 47-7 win over the TCNJ Lions. Frostburg racked up 405 yards in offense behind 192 on the ground. FSU also scored twice on special teams.

In its home opener, Frostburg rolled to another 34-7 victory, this time over Rowan. Senior Connor Cox became Frostburg's all-time leader in passing yards, senior Jamaal Morant eclipsed 2,000 career rushing yards and Fitzgerald became FSU's all-time winningest coach.

Cox has completed 35-of-56 passes for 717 yards and five scores in his three games this fall. Junior receiver Malik Morris currently leads the nation in yards per reception (37.6) after hauling in eighth receptions for 301 yards and two touchdowns.

The Bobcat ground attack is powered by a pair of seniors. Morant has carried the ball 55 times for 243 yards and two touchdowns, while Grayson Boyce has rushed for 163 yards and one score on 33 attempts. The Frostburg offense is currently third in the league in scoring (38.3) and third in total offense (422.0).

Defensively, the Bobcats are led by junior linebacker Wayne Palmer, who has 27 tackles with 2.5 sacks. Senior Dre'Quan Reed is second with 18 tackles and a team-best 4.5 TFLs and three sacks. FSU leads the nation in sacks per game (5.0), is sixth in DIII in scoring defense (7.0) and ninth in total defense (204.3).

#### Head Coach DeLane Fitzgerald

DeLane Fitzgerald is in his fifth season at the helm of Frostburg and has pushed the program to new heights in a short amount of time. He has guided the Bobcats to 34 wins in four years, including 10 wins in 2016 and 11 wins last fall. Fitzgerald has increased his win total in each of his four seasons after inheriting a 1-9 team.

Two weeks ago, Fitzgerald became the program's all-time winningest coach with 34 victories. He is the 13th head coach in the program's 58-year history.

Fitzgerald was one of 23 head football coaches hired in 2014 in Division III. Among those 23, he is third with 34 wins, but is the only coach in the group with two 10+ win seasons.

#### The Rankings

Frostburg moved up to fifth in the D3football.com Week 5 Poll, the highest ranking in program history. FSU entered the season ranked eighth and have spent the last 22 weeks in the D3football.com poll. The third American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Top 25 Poll was also released this week and Frostburg check in at No. 8.

#### First To Score

Two weeks ago, the Bobcats scored first against Rowan on a 68-yard touchdown pass from Connor Cox to Malik Morris and the Bobcats rolled to a 34-7 win. The victory for Frostburg marks the 22nd-consecutive victory when scoring first. Under DeLane Fitzgerald, FSU is 29-3 overall when having the initial score.

#### Tough To Come By

In his four seasons at the helm, Fitzgerald has led the Bobcats to a 22-1 record when holding opponents to less than 100 yards rushing.

#### Program History

Frostburg is in its 58th year of collegiate football in 2018 and the Bobcats have an overall record of 269-281-8. The Bobcats have made two appearances in the NCAA Playoffs (1993 & 2017) and have played in eight ECAC Bowl Games.

#### Road Wins

Since the start of the 2016 season, the Bobcats have earned 10 wins in their last 11 road games during the regular season. Including the NCAA Playoffs and ECAC Bowl Game, the Bobcats have collected 13 wins in their last 15 games away from Bobcat Stadium.

#### Elite Company

In 2016 and 2017, the Bobcats posted back-to-back double-digit win seasons for the first time in program history. Only six other programs in Division III accomplished the same feat in the past two seasons (Mount Union, Mary Hardin-Baylor, UW-Oshkosh, St. Thomas, North Central and Wittenberg).

FSU is one of 12 teams to reach the national quarterfinals in the same timespan.

#### 63 And Counting

Through three games in his senior season, Bobcat signal caller Connor Cox is currently eighth in Division III among active quarterbacks with 63 career touchdowns.

In the win over Rowan, Cox threw for 257 yards and became FSU's all-time leader in passing yards, surpassing Bobcat Hall of Famer Grant Burrough.

#### By Land and Air

Cox is one of nine active quarterbacks in Division III who have thrown for 4,000 yards and run for 1,000 in their career. Of those nine QBs, Cox is fifth in total yards amassing 7,608 total yards behind 6,541 passing and 1,067 rushing yards.



#### Mr. 2,000

On the final play of the first quarter in the win over Rowan, senior running back Jamaal Morant ran for 10 yards and eclipsed the 2,000 yard plateau for his career. He is the eighth Frostburg player to accomplish the feat and the first since Shanorm Young ran for 2,230 from 2005-07.

#### Big Play Threat

Bobcat junior receiver Malik Morris currently leads the nation in yards per reception at 37.6. In the season opener, he hauled in a 92-yard pass in the first quarter, while in the win over Rowan, he scored the game's first touchdown with a 68-yard pitch-and-catch from senior Connor Cox.

Morris has caught eight passes this season and six of those receptions have gone for at least 20 yards.

#### Pitch A Tent

The Frostburg defense has made a living in the backfield's of their opponents since the beginning of the 2016 season. During those 27 games, the Bobcats are averaging 9.4 tackles for loss and 3.55 sacks per contest.

#### He Made It!

Former Frostburg All-American defensive lineman Niles Scott was signed to the San Francisco 49ers practice squad following trainign camp. On Sept. 12, Scott was signed to the Denver Broncos practice squad.

Scott finished his senior season as a Bobcat last fall by being named to the AP Little All-America First Team and the D3football.com All-America Second Team. He finished the season with 51 total tackles, including 16.5 tackles for loss (104 yds.) and 10 sacks (77 yds.).

#### Oh Captain, My Captain

A quintuple of Frostburg players will serve as team captains for Saturday's matchup with TCNJ: seniors Riley Hartman, Noah Teeter, Dre'Quan Reed, Boakum Vital and Grayson Boyce.
