### PRIOR TO KICKOFF

The Frostburg State Bobcats travel to Athens, W.Va. this Saturday to battle Concord in an MEC showdown at 12:00 pm.

The Bobcats lost their first Division II football game a week ago to W.Va. State 20-17. Last season, Frostburg finished off a 41-year run at DIII with a perfect 9-0 regular season. The Bobcats also won the New Jersey Athletic Conference Title, reached the second round of the NCAA Division III playoffs and hosted its first home NCAA Playoff game since 1993.

Concord dropped its season opener at fourth-ranked Notre Dame (Ohio) 33-10. The Mountain Lions scored first, a 21-yard FG, before Notre Dame scored 20-consecutive points en route to the win. Kyle Akin powered Concord in the loss with 212 yards passing with one TD on 16-of-32 attempts.

The Bobcats have won their last five road games and have come out victorious in 15 of their 16 games away from Bobcat Stadium.

### PROGRAM HISTORY

Frostburg is in its 59th year of collegiate football in 2019 and the Bobcats have an overall record of 271-283-8. The Bobcats have made three appearances in the NCAA DIII Playoffs (1993, 2017 & 2018) and have played in eight ECAC Bowl Games.

The Bobcats have won eight or more games 10 times, nine or more games eight times and have eclipsed the 10-win plateau four times.

### AWAY FROM BOBCAT STADIUM

The Frostburg football program has been highly successful away from Bobcat Stadium over the last five seasons, boasting 20 wins to just five losses. In fact, the Bobcats were 5-0 outside Frostburg last fall, while in 2017, FSU was 7-1

The Bobcats have enjoyed great success in the month of September, owning an 11-5 mark over the last five seasons. Going back seven years, Frostburg has collected 15 wins in the first month of the college football season.

### THE POSTSEASON

DeLane Fitzgerald has been at the helm of the Bobcat program for five full seasons and he has quickly turned Frostburg into a team that competes for a spot in the postseason.

After inheriting a 1-9 squad, Fitzgerald had the Bobcats in an ECAC Bowl in just three seasons and the Bobcats made back-to-back NCAA Playoff appearances in '17 and '18 for the only time in school history.

### PRESEASON POLL

Frostburg was picked to finish ninth in its first season as a member of the Mountain East Conference. The Bobcats received 26 votes and were selected ahead of W.Va. Wesleyan (23 pts.) and Wheeling (13 pts.).

Notre Dame (Ohio) was picked to win the league and received 10 of 11 first-place votes. Notre Dame advanced to the NCAA Playoff semifinals last fall.

### A VICTORY WOULD

- Lift the Bobcats to 277-283-8 overall in 59 seasons
- Land Fitzgerald his 42nd victory at the helm of Frostburg
- Be the 21st victory away from Frostburg for the Bobcats in five seasons
- Land FSU its sixth-straight road wins
- Be Frostburg's first DII win since leaving Division III
- Be the first win over a school from the state of West Virginia since FSU defeated West Virginia Tech, 38-21 in 1999

### 30 IS THE MAGIC NUMBER

The Bobcats scored over 30 points in nine of their 11 games a season ago, and under Fitzgerald, the Bobcats are 26-1 when scoring 30 or more.

### TOUGH TO COME BY

In his five-plus seasons at the helm, Fitzgerald has led the Bobcats to a 27-1 record when holding opponents to less than 100 yards rushing.

Frostburg allowed just three 100 yard rushers last season and two came against Salisbury and its triple option attack.

### OFFENSIVE MIGHT

Over the last two seasons, Frostburg has re-written the record books in terms of offensive output. In 2017, the Bobcats set the program record with 5,439 yards in total offense. In 2018, FSU finished with 4,795 yards in offense, the second-best mark in program history.

### OFFENSIVE MIGHT 2.0

The Bobcats have scored 61 offensive touchdowns in each of the last two seasons. In 2017, Frostburg's 61 TDs broke the program record of 53 touchdowns that was set in 1990.

### IT ALL STARTS WITH DEFENSE

Frostburg has emerged as one of the nation's most complete defensive units over the last four seasons and has produced a pair of All-Americans in William Sewell and Niles Scott. The Bobcats have ranked inside the top 40 nationally in total defense in each of the last four years, including a national ranking of ninth in 2016.

### BLOCK PARTY

When Fitzgerald arrived on campus in the winter of 2014, he promised Frostburg would be dominant on special teams and his squads have delivered every season.

The Bobcats blocked six kicks in each of his first three seasons. In 2017, FSU turned back four kicks, while last fall, Frostburg finished with five blocks and all five came on punts.

### THE BOBCAST

The Frostburg athletic department releases a weekly podcast known as the Bobcast early each week that talks with all in-season head coaches regarding their team's performances, upcoming games, individual players and much more.

### AFCA GOOD WORKS

Bobcat senior long snapper Ryan Landis was nominated prior to the start of the 2019 season for the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA) Good Works Team. Landis is a volunteer fire fighter, helps with Beautify the Burg and is involved in both the Frost Elementary and Grantsville Elementary Reading Programs.

### ACADEMIC GRIDIRON

FSU senior defensive back Vincent Persichetti was nominated in early August for the William V. Campbell Trophy of the National Football Foundation (NFF) that is awarded to the nation's top football scholar-athlete. Persichetti carries a 3.57 GPA in the classroom and majors in law & society.

### ALL-NJAC RETURNERS

### LAST TIME OUT

Frostburg opened its much anticipated inaugural season at NCAA Division II with West Virginia State last Thursday night at Bobcat Stadium and fans in attendance were certainly not disappointed.

The Bobcats suffered a narrow 20-17 loss, but they led 17-8 midway through the third. The Yellow Jackets scored the go-ahead touchdown with 3:44 to go in the fourth when Austin Hensley tossed a 14-yard touchdown.

Following a W.Va. State field goal in the third, Frostburg forced the Jackets into turnovers on their next three possessions. W.Va. State fumbled the ball away at the FSU one, the Jackets again put the ball on the turf on their next possession on first down and FSU forced the visitors to turn the ball over on downs after a second fumble at the Bobcat one.

Frostburg had one final chance to the tie game following Hensley's TD toss, but junior Jeremy Harrison's 51-yard field goal attempt fell just short of the crossbar with 12 seconds to play.

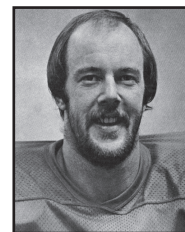
